## Polices for Health and Safety at Work

- 4, A safe place of work with safe access to and egress from it.
- 5, A healthy working environment.

In order to involve all employees in the formation and the execution of this policy, The company will seek to ensure effective communication and consultation with them via management and the company safety committee.

It is the duty of employee to work in accordance with the company safety policy. To this end each employee must accept and carry out his/her responsibility to:

- 1, Act with care to prevent injury to themselves or others.
- 2, Report all accidents, dangerous occurrences, damage to equipment and any other Potential hazards that may have health and safety implications for themselves or others.
- 3, Follow the agreed working procedures including the correct use of safety equipment and PPE.

This health and safety policy will reviewed as appropriate and any revisions will be brought to the immediate notice of all employees.
